ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO COMPEL
TURNOVER OF CERTAIN VEHICLES

THIS CAUSE is before the court upon the receiver's motion to compel the turnover of certain vehicles in possession of Yves Theodule, the brother of defendant George Theodule [DE # 159]. The motion indicates that a copy of the motion was properly served on Yves Theodule and his counsel, and that the SEC has no objections to the turnover.

When no timely response was filed to this motion, the court entered an order to show cause why the motion should not be granted. *See* De # 172. A copy of the order was sent to Yves Theodule, but no response has been filed.


Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that:

1. The motion to compel the turnover of certain vehicles in the possession of Yves Theodule [DE # 159] is **GRANTED**.
2. Pursuant to the court's December 29, 2008 receivership order, Yves Theodule and his agents are directed to transfer title and possession of the following vehicles:
 - a. 1985 Chevrolet Monte Carlo, VIN Number 1G1GZ37G8GR208179
