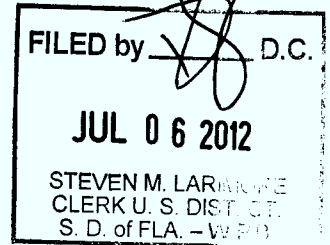

ORDER GRANTING IN PART JOINT MOTION TO SEAL

**THIS CAUSE** is before the Court upon the parties' Amended Joint Emergency Motion to Seal [ECF No. 99]. Having reviewed the motion, the Court finds compelling reasons justifying the restriction of public access to the specified documents. *Wilson v. Am. Motors Corp.*, 759 F.2d 1568, 1570-71 (11th Cir. 1985). The documents contain information designated by Bank of America as confidential during discovery that reveals nonpublic information about the Bank's customers and personnel and the policies the Bank uses to identify suspicious activity and prevent fraud.

However, while the parties request that the Court seal the entire motions and have them replaced on the docket with redacted versions of the same, the Court finds that the Bank's confidential information can be protected by sealing the confidential portions of the previous filings and allowing the remainder to stay unsealed by attaching the redacted versions to this Order to be filed concurrently herewith.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that:


1. The motion to seal [ECF No. 99] is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**.
2. Each of the following filings and all of their exhibits shall be **SEALED** and removed

3. The redacted version of the Receiver's Corrected Motion for Reconsideration and exhibits attached thereto which is included with this Order shall be entered on the docket unsealed.
