ORDER SETTING HEARING

**THIS CAUSE** is before the court upon the receiver's motion for approval of settlement agreement and consent final judgment [DE # 212, Case No. 08-81565]. This is an action to, among other things, avoid and recover fraudulent transfers pursuant to Fla. Stat. 726.101 et seq.


It is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that:

1. A hearing on the above-described motion is set for **8:30 a.m.** on **THURSDAY, March 11, 2010**, in courtroom five at the U.S. Courthouse, 701 Clematis Street, West Palm Beach, Florida. The hearing shall last no longer than forty minutes.
2. The parties shall be prepared to discuss why the proposed settlement (requiring defendant to fully cooperate with the receiver's investigation and assigning to the receiver all rights to claims and causes of action against George Theodule) is reasonable in light of the allegation that defendant received "at least \$493,000 of fraudulent transfers from Creative Capital for little or no consideration." *See* Compl. ¶ 49. Further, the receiver shall be prepared to articulate his efforts in prosecuting this action.
