PLAINTIFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Plaintiff, Jonathan E. Perlman, Esq., the court-appointed Receiver (the "Receiver") of Creative Capital Consortium, LLC and related receivership entities, by and through his undersigned counsel, hereby responds to this Court's Order to Show Cause issued on September 29, 2010 [DE 25] and states as follows:

1. On August 21, 2009, the Receiver filed a complaint (the "Complaint") against Showcase Investment Group, Inc. (the "Defendant") as an ancillary proceeding to *Securities and Exchange Commission v. Creative Capital Consortium, LLC, A Creative Capital Concept\$, LLC and George L. Theodule*, Case No. 08-81565-Civ-Hurley/Hopkins, pending in the United States District Court, Southern District of Florida. [DE 1].

2. On August 8, 2010, the Receiver filed his Motion For Clerk's Default Against Defendant Showcase Investment Group, Inc. [DE 15].

3. On August 11, 2010, the Court entered its Clerk's Default against Defendant Showcase Investment Group, Inc. [DE 17].

4. On September 1, 2010, the Receiver filed his Motion for Entry of Final Judgment and Memorandum of Law [DE 22].

5. On September 3, 2010, the Defendant filed its Motion to Set Aside Clerk's Default Under Rule 55 (C) and Memorandum of Law [DE 24].

6. Thereafter, the Parties engaged in substantive good faith settlement discussions. In this regard, as part of his due diligence in connection with the proposed settlement, the Receiver requested that the Defendant provide certain financial information and other documentation relevant to the settlement and the corresponding claims and defenses asserted by the parties.

7. The Parties anticipate that they will be able to agree to reasonable settlement terms, contingent upon the review by the Receiver of the Defendant's due diligence information, within the next thirty (30) days.
