ENDORSED ORDER regarding the Receiver's Motion for Default Judgment (DE #32). The instant motion seeks a joint and several judgment against defendants in the amount of \$207,000 for two fraudulent transfers: one in the amount of \$197,000 and another in the amount of \$10,000. The amended complaint alleges the \$197,000 transfer, and the allegations support a joint and several judgment. The amended complaint, however, does not allege the \$10,000 transfer, and the exhibits attached to the motion for default judgment show that the transfer was received by defendant Daniel Lavan, Jr only. The Receiver SHALL, within five (5) days of entry of this order, submit a supplemental brief to his motion for default explaining why the default judgment should include the \$10,000 transfer.
