**THIS CAUSE** is before the Court upon the parties' Stipulated Motion to Extend Deadline to Disclose Expert Witnesses [ECF No. 33]. The parties have agreed on the following schedule and represent that this modification will not affect the trial date.

3. Defendant and Third-Party Defendants shall disclose their experts no later than **February 4, 2013**, which includes the Rule 26(a)(2)(B) requirement for the disclosure of written expert reports which conform to the prescriptions of the Rule.
